When you need a calibrator, standard, counter/timer, or similar piece of precision measurement equipment—but your budget won't accommodate a new instrument—you might consider purchasing used equipment. Why buy used equipment from Fluke Calibration?

Fluke Calibration takes the risk out of purchasing used equipment. To qualify as Fluke Calibration Certified, an instrument must undergo a rigorous refurbishing process:

- All engineering updates for safety, software, and firmware are performed to bring the instrument up to current specifications and performance.
- The instrument is fully tested to ensure it meets specification.
- The instrument is calibrated and furnished with a certificate of calibration.
- The instrument is cleaned and any cosmetic repairs are performed.
- Required accessories and user manual are included.
- The full manufacturer's warranty is included.

This process is performed by Fluke Calibration's qualified personnel, giving confidence and great value to used equipment purchased from Fluke Calibration. And each Fluke Calibration Certified purchase is fully guaranteed within the terms of the manufacturer's warranty.

Eliminate the risk

Used equipment is widely available. But when you buy precision measurement equipment from a source other than the manufacturer, you take multiple risks:

- You don't know how old the instrument is.
- You don't know how the instrument was used or whether it was over stressed before you acquired it.
- You may not know how and when the instrument was calibrated.



- You don't know if the instrument has been repaired, or if repairs were done correctly.
- You don't know if the instrument is still actively supported or if it has been discontinued.
- You may not get a manual.
- You don't have a warranty from the manufacturer.
